## Create a Microsoft Login


1. At first, check if you have a Microsoft Login with a private mail address.

Try to log into the website as follows: https://login.live.com

To open a Microsoft account, you must use a private mail address. (You can't use the FHGR e-mail address!)






1. Open the link as follows:

https://azureforeducation.microsoft.com/devtools


2. Click the blue "Sign In" button.



3. Log in with your Microsoft account.




4. Enter the student email address.




Now an email will be sent to your student mail address.

- 7. Accept the terms on the website.




8. After accepting, you will have access to the Microsoft Azure Dev environment. Downloads and licence-keys of various Microsoft software are now available.
